Dansk Selskab for Automatisk Genkendelse af Mønstre (DSAGM) – The Danish Pattern Recognition Society at a was formed in 1976 such that it could be among the first national societies to join the [International Association of Pattern Recognition](#)(IAPR) in 1978. IAPR was established then to serve as an international umbrella organization for scientific and professional societies focused on pattern recognition, computer vision, and image processing.

The image analysis groups formed in the beginning of the 1980s at the Technical University of Denmark at the Institute for Mathematical Statistics and Operations Research (IMSOR) led by Knut Conradsen; at the University of Copenhagen in the Department for Computer Science led by Peter Johansen; and at Aalborg University in the Laboratory for Image Analysis in the Department for Electronic Systems led by Erik Granum have been at the core of the DSAGM.
